Instructional Equipment 2014-2015 - Funding update

The State has allocated one-time funding or the Instructional Equipment and Library Materials budget for this year. In doing so they have changed their requirements in order to ensure that the Districts are expending their funds in a Expeditious manner.

The primary changes are:

- All funds must be encumbered by the end of this fiscal year
- District are required to produce a five year expenditure projection to be submitted to the State on Dec 1, 2014.

The District's allocation for this year is \$ 1,309,578

As in the past, the goal is to link planning with budgeting to allocate resource requests, so the PRPP process is an essential component. All the Deans were asked to rank their top five priorities and were initially funded in the following manner.
