IELM 2017-18 Funding Allocations

The total amount allocated for the Instructional Equipment and Library Materials (IELM) budget in 2017-2018 is \$750,000. This represents a reduction of \$309,005 from 2016-17 IELM funds. Requests submitted in section 2.4c of the PRPP were compiled by cluster and distributed to deans and areas for priority ranking. The following table provides an at-a-glance look at the recommended amounts for allocation and corresponding percentage of the total budget. The 2016-17 cluster and area allocations are also provided for historical perspective.
